Basic Granny Square Scarf

Materials List - Acrylic Yarn in various colors

Yarn for One Granny Square

Center = 2 yds (183cm)

Round One = 3.5 yds (320cm)

Round Two + Edging = 13.5 yds (1235cm)

Hook & Notions

H/8 (5mm) or appropriate for yarn used

Yarn needle

Gauge

One Square

5" (12.5cm) X 5" (12.5cm)



(Make 12 granny squares or as many as desired using same color combination for each granny square or a different color combination for each granny square. To avoid weaving in ends, try a self-striping yarn such as Bernat Mosaic.)

Center: With A color, ch 4, sl st into 1st ch to form a ring.

Rnd 1: With A color, ch 3 (counts as dc), 2 dc in ring, *ch 3, 3 dc in ring; repeat from * twice, ending with ch 3, join with sl st to 3rd ch of beg ch 3. Fasten off.

Rnd 2: Join color B with slip knot on hook, insert hook in ch-3 sp, yo, pull through 2 loops on hook, ch 2, 2 dc in same ch-3 sp (half corner made), *ch 2, [3 dc, ch 3, 3 dc] in next ch-3 sp (corner made), repeat from * twice, ending with ch 2, 3 dc in beg sp, ch 3, join with sl st to 3rd ch of beg ch 3. Fasten off.

Rnd 3: With color C join yarn in corner sp as Rnd 2, ch 2, 2 dc in same ch-3 sp (half corner made), *ch 2, 3 dc in next ch-2 sp, ch 2, [3 dc, ch 3, 3 dc] in next ch-3 sp (corner made), repeat from * twice, ending with ch 2, 3 dc in next ch-2 sp, ch 2, 3 dc in beg sp, ch 3, join with sl st to 3rd ch of beg ch 3.

Rnd 4: Ch 3, dc in each st across edge, 3 dc in each corner, join with sl st in 3rd ch of beg ch 3. Fasten off and weave in ends.

Join: With right sides together, join yarn in corner sts working sc through front loop of front granny square and back loop of back granny square, sc across edge matching sts to next corner. (See Video #3)

Finish Edge: With RS facing, working in back loop only, sc around edge with 3 sc in corners. Join with sl st in 1st sc. Fasten off and weave in ends.

Videos –Join Granny Squares - #1 Whipstitch Seam & Weave Seam; #2 Chain Seam & Single Crochet Seam; #3 Single Crochet with Single Loops and #4 Chain Stitch & Dc2tog.
