## Light & Sassy Scarf

### Materials List:

#### Yarn

1 Bernat® Baby Sport (100% acrylic, 12.3oz [350g], 1256yd [1148m]) 3/Light, in color Baby Ecu (A)

#### Plus one of the following:

##### Valentine

2 Red Heart Boutique Sassy Fabric (100% polyester, 30yd [27m])  
6/Super Bulky, in color 9934 Red Dot (B)

##### Classic

2 Red Heart® Boutique™ Sassy Lace™ (100% nylon, 27yd [24m])  
6/Super Bulky, in color 9001 Vanilla (B)

##### Midnight

2 Red Heart Boutique Sassy Fabric (100% polyester, 30yd [27m])  
Super Bulky/6 in color 9931 Black Dot (B)

Hooks & Notions	Gauge	Measurements
US H-8 (5mm) Tapestry Needle	Not important	5" x 63" (including ruffle)

**Back Ruffle Single Crochet (BRsc):** With Sassy Fabric in back, insert hook through top two loops of the next st, insert hook through next space along top of fabric, yo, pull through, 2 A loops on hook, yo, pull through 2 loops (sc made).

**Back Ruffle Treble Crochet (BRtr):** With Sassy Fabric in back, yo twice on hook, insert hook through top two loops of the next st, insert hook through next space along top fabric, yo pull through, (yo, pull through 2 loops on hook) 3 times (tr made).

**To Begin (or End) Ruffled Rose:** Fold over so first 2 (or last 2) Fabric spaces are doubled and work together.



**Note:** When working with Sassy Fabric, gently fold ruffle in half as you move Sassy Fabric over to next Sassy Fabric space for next sc.

With A ch 13. Working in blo, sc in 2<sup>nd</sup> ch from hook and sc in remaining chs. (12 sc)

Row 1: Work BRsc in each sc.

Row 2: Ch 3, turn. Work BRtr in base of ch-3 and each st across. (12)

Continue working Row 2 until piece measures”.

Finishing Rows

Row 1: Ch 1, turn. BRsc across row.

Row 2: Repeat Row 1.

Make 1 and fasten off. Cut fabric leaving 3 extra spaces. Do not fasten off second piece.

Unite Both Ends.

Place both sc ends together. Insert hook through top two loops of each sc section. Work BRsc. Work across row.

Ch 1 and turn. As you work across final row, end off current fabric and include remaining fabric from other end as you complete row. Fasten off A. Weave in any ends.
