## Sparkling Wine Boa

### Materials List:

#### Yarn

1 ball Bernat® Handicrafter® Crochet Thread (100% acrylic, 3oz 85g, 371yd [339m]) in color 31308 Orchid (A)

Red Heart® Boutique™ Ribbons™ (75% acrylic, 25% polyester, 3.5oz [100g], 42yd [38m]) 6/super bulky, in color 1933 Grapevine (B)

Short – 1 ball

Long – 2 balls

Hooks & Notions	Gauge	Measurements
US G-6 (4mm)	6 sc = 1” (2.5cm)	Short - 36.5” (91.25cm) Long - 73” (182.5cm)
Needle		
Thread		



**Back Ruffle Double Crochet (BRdc):** With B in back of A row, yo, insert hook through top two loops of the next A st, insert hook through next ladder along top of B ribbon, yo, pull through, 3 loops on hook, (yo, pull through 2 loops) twice (dc made).

**Note:** After ruffle row, gently pull ruffles down to even ladders.

**To Begin (or End) Ribbon Yarn:** Fold over first 3 (or last 3) ladders and work together.

**To Add New Ribbon Ball:** Overlap last 3 ladders of one ball with first 3 ladders of new ball and work together.

### Boa

With A, ch 21, sc in 2<sup>nd</sup> ch from hook, sc in each ch. (20 sc) Ch 2, turn.

Row 1: Do not skip 1<sup>st</sup> st, place ribbon across back, work BRdc across row. Ch 2, turn. (20 dc)

Repeat Row 1 until desired length is reached. End off. Weave in ends.
